Application Process Change

When an adult applies to scouting, their application will be held in a "pending" status until the criminal background check (CBC) comes back OK. This makes sense! It also means you need to factor this wait time into your 2-deep leadership schedule. You have to wait until the CBC passes and the application is accepted before have that adult come on overnight trips or extended contact with scouts.

Other changes are implementing in Registrar Tools , and the old Unit Recharter tools are slowly going away as the new process of leaders registering for a year from their date of registration (not with recharter) becomes the new norm.
