

Hooked on Scouting Fishing for Popcorn Leader Resource Sheet

Introduction

Popcorn is important to Scouting and this activity gives you a fun way to introduce the topic of fees and how Scouts can fund their own adventures through popcorn and other unit fundraising. This is a good opportunity to offer a snack. Of course, they will eat some popcorn, but supplementing with goldfish crackers and gummy fish or worms just makes it even more fun.

Fishing for Popcorn

This is so easy you probably don't need this Resource Sheet! Watch the Hooked on Scouting Popcorn Fishing video for visual instructions.

Materials

- Popcorr
- Dowel Rod (pole), ¼" x 12" or whatever you have available
- String or fishing line
- Fishing Lures Not too big! This type works well.



- Clear plastic cups
- Small plates

Directions

- Make the fishing pole
 - Attach fishing lure to a piece of string (8-12 "long or shorter is fine)
 - Tie the other end of the string to the pole
- Give each player a pole, clear cup, and popcorn on a plate
- Instruct them to fill up the cup with popcorn. You can make it a race for added challenge, or just let them chat while they fish for popcorn.
 - Optional: write on the clear cup things that popcorn can fund like "uniforms, registration, and camp"
